



### **Build Your Own Portable Chicken Coop**

The coop pictured above was built by the instructor for his flock from re-claimed materials for very little cost. The coop we will build in class will be similar but a bit smaller and lighter. It will be suitable for a flock of up to 10 laying hens and will be built as three separate modules that will come together for a 12' X 3' base and a 6' X 3' covered roost above. The coop will have hinged doors for easy access for cleaning and for egg collection. Since students may wish to use re-claimed materials for their own coop, the goal of the class is for students to walk away with the plans to build a coop and with the hands-on experience to feel confident in doing it themselves. The coop that we will build in class will be sold in the school store. There will be no materials charge for this class. Use of a cordless screwdriver, staple gun, and hammer will be required.

**Optional Tool List:** Cordless Screwdriver, hammer, measuring tape, pencils, staple gun

Tools will be provided by the school if you do not have them.
