The weekend will consist of two essential aspects of twig work: acquiring and then using the materials. After discussion of the process and a rough design of your intended product, we'll take to the woods, no matter the weather, and select saplings for the shelves. To make the shelves, you will need both the sapling trunk and branches. In order to allow you ultimate flexibility in your shelving design, we will ask you to select your project size and shelving when you register. This will give you the option to use pine or hardwood of your choice. We will have natural Tung oil available for your use, or you may stain your project at home. Carving tools will be available for you to use or bring your own. Twig work has infinite possibility and we'll try to explore many of them as well as cover the basics of the work.
